



## 2012 TOWN OF BUENA VISTA EMERGENCY POTABLE WATER PERMIT

In accordance with Ordinance No. 15 (Series of 2002) of the Town of Buena Vista Municipal Code, and Resolution No. 65 (Series of 2002) the undersigned hereby agrees to the following:

This permit is issued for **temporary** service to a residence or facility, for service drawn directly from **Hydrant #133**. This permit is valid until December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current calendar year unless written approval is obtained from the Public Works Director. An Emergency Potable Water Permit may be considered null and void depending on available water or if misuse is discovered. In the event of a Stage III water warning, all Emergency Potable Water Permit holders will cease drawing water from Town services.

**A).** The fee assessed shall be one hundred dollars (**\$100.00**) for the permit, plus three dollars and eighty-one cents (**\$3.81**) for every one thousand (1,000) gallons of water, or portion thereof, drawn in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons. These fees will be billed to the permittee upon removal of the meter, when a meter is used. In the case of “load counts” the submission of a **daily** volume usage log by the permittee will be submitted to the Public Works Shop for invoicing.

**B).** Two checks, made payable to the Town of Buena Vista, shall be submitted at the time the permit is issued, one for the permit fee and one used as a refundable security deposit on material provided by the Public Works Department. Deposit amounts are listed in the chart below. The security deposit check will be returned to the permittee upon receipt and inspection of such materials. Only when materials are found to be damaged or not returned will the security deposit be used to replace materials that were provided by the Public Works Department.

A) Emergency Potable Water decals will be issued to the permittee for placement in vehicle windshields that will be used for water delivery.

B) **Decals will be displayed in the lower left corner of the windshield** so as not to interfere with driving, but visible to law officials and Town Staff.

C) Quality: The Town of Buena Vista makes no promise or guarantee of the potability or water quality, once emergency water is withdrawn from the Town's Distribution System.
