**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BUENA VISTA, COLORADO,
AMENDING SECTIONS 7-93 AND 8-42 OF THE BUENA VISTA
MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN
ANIMALS AND STORING OF VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the Town's current parking and animal regulations do not address certain issues that the Town desires to regulate;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees desires to clarify these issues and finds these amendments in the best interest of the Town and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BUENA VISTA, COLORADO:

Section 1. Sec. 7-93 of the Buena Vista Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (1) No person shall keep animals or fowl within the corporate limits of the Town unless such person has a valid permit to do so, and no animal or fowl shall be allowed to run or fly at large.
- (2) The keeping of roosters and swine within the Town is prohibited.

Section 2. Sec. 8-42(b) of the Buena Vista Municipal Code is hereby amended to by the addition of a new subsection (4) to read as follows:

- (4) No more than ten (10) vehicles shall be stored or parked outside on any properties in any zone district where a residential use is authorized with a single-family detached home provided that such vehicles are stored or parked in compliance with this section. This limitation shall include no more than two (2) inoperable vehicles as permitted by subsection (c) below if such vehicles are located on the property. Under no circumstances shall there be more than ten (10) vehicles stored or parked on a property at any time. ATVs, snowmobiles, and other similar vehicles count towards the ten (10) vehicle limit set forth herein.


